Overview

Grades K - 8

Multiplayer: 1-4 players per game

There's a dragon on the loose and it's looking at your village for its next meal. You and other brave villagers are competing for Courage Swords to win the right to face the dragon and save the village. You'll need all of your math smarts, a good strategy, some sneaky gadgets and a bit of luck to get your chance.


The aim of the game is to collect as much Courage as possible. The player with the most Courage at the end of the game (a preset number of turns or time) wins the chance to take on the dragon.

Players roll the dice and advance around the board. With each turn, players can earn Strength by correctly answering Math questions. This Strength can be converted into Courage when a player manages to be the first to reach each elusive Courage Sword.

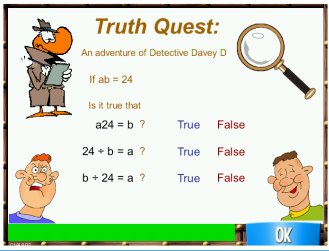
